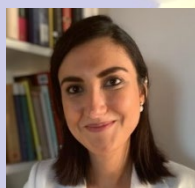
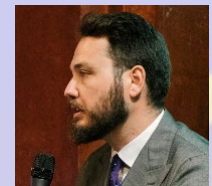
**Lyria Bennett Moses** *The EU is proposing harmonized rules for “AI”. What is AI and is it the right regulatory target for what the EU seeks to achieve? Can a definition of a set of technologies ever be technology neutral and future proof?*
